Team Size Discussion:

- All 2009 Girls will be invited out to skate with Novice girls to move up and potentially play HL/Rep. Email will be sent to qualifying girls to see about interest to have enough brought up to make Novice Girls House League team. If players are playing Novice HL there will be no cash cheque required for TryOut fee. If 2009 Tyke players play Rep hockey, they will need to pay the \$40 Try out fee. All members agreed that girls will be contacted and agreed on format to cash cheques.
- Midget boys can not determine team sizes until try outs for Juniors are complete.

2. Try Out Committee Updates:

- Try outs will now be read as Player Evaluation. A new criteria for evaluation has been formatted and will be posted on the website. Each player will be evaluated on a variety of skills. Records will be kept for future evaluations to maintain player progress reports.
- Evaluation Criteria will be based on variety of concepts including stick handling, skills, speed, leadership, drive, hockey IQ, etc. Ranked on scale of 1-7, 1 being lowest and 7 highest.
- All kids that are attending AE evaluations must skate with REP evaluation ice times. There will not be a separate evaluation for AE following the REP evaluation. Once the Rep evaluations are complete, the AE may be given 1 hour of ice to skate at the request of the coach.
- Evaluations will be given a minimum of three hours ice time. Player cuts can be made after the first three hours, after the first exhibition game, then after the second exhibition game. Rep teams will be posted on the website Sunday evening. Once this team is posted. The players remaining will be given a skate time for AE and LL.
- Committee members are working to re-word Policy #8 and Policy #10.
- Three Evaluators will be at try outs for each age division. Rep Coach may sit with evaluators if they so choose.
- Lee made a motion proposing No Rust Off Skate this year. 16 agreed, 1 opposed.
*No Rust off Skate will occur this year.
- Scott will send player evaluation criteria to Rochelle and it will be posted on the website.

Mark Sutherland made a motion to approve the Evaluation Format: All Approved.

3. Girls Hockey Awards

Industrial Source Supply- 1 selection in each division for girls hockey award.

Campbell Fresh Gear- 1 selection in each division for Most Improved Player

4. WAVE

5 Goalie Clinic

Aaron would prefer 12 but will not turn away any other goalies interested from our organization. Approximate cost to SHMH is \$1700. Cost to Players \$125.00. SHMH will subsidize remaining balance. Mark made motion to approve Goalie Clinic and Registration fee of \$125.00. 1st Scott Boghart, 2nd Lisa Campbell.
